Terms of Reference

The “Friends of St Mary and St Milburgh” encourages financial support for the upkeep of the building to ensure the advancement of the Christian religion.

This includes

- help towards the cost of repairs
- help towards maintenance costs
- help towards raising funds for the above
- where appropriate, for members to give their personal services for the promotion of the above

The “Friends of St Mary and St Milburgh” will be run by a committee with a Chairman and a Secretary.

Two members of St Mary and St Milburgh Parochial Church Council will sit on the “Friends” committee.

The role of the “Friends of St Mary and St Milburgh” is to raise funds which will support work which the Parochial Church Council, with the Incumbent and Church Wardens, has agreed and has received approval from the relevant bodies under the “Care of Churches Measure”.

Membership of the “Friends of St Mary and St Milburgh” is open to anyone who would like to join. This includes people who live both within and outside the parish. Church family members are also welcome to join the Friends.
